1. Mare Owner's Expenses

The Mare Owner shall be solely responsible for all charges and expenses in connection with the Mare, including but not limited to: veterinary services (collection, insemination, scanning, treatment, drugs, worming, treatment of infections, preventive measures, examinations and related services), mare handling fees, agistment, semen transport (if applicable), and any other mare-related costs.

2. Liability and Termination

- 2.1. It is acknowledged that Maraboon Rural Vet Services operates independently of the Stallion Owners.
- 2.2. The Stallion Owners shall bear no liability whatsoever for any injury, disease, accident, sickness, loss or death sustained by the Mare or her progeny, however arising.
- 2.3. In the event that the Stallion dies or becomes unfit for service, or the above-named Mare dies, this Agreement shall be deemed null and void and any Service Fee paid shall be refunded in full.
- 2.4. All agistment and veterinary expenses shall remain the sole responsibility of the Mare Owner and must be paid directly to the nominated breeding centre as required.

3. Failure to Achieve Pregnancy

If the Mare fails to become pregnant despite appropriate veterinary attention and documentation evidencing reasonable diligence by the Mare Owner and Maraboon Rural Vet Services, the Stallion Owner's liability shall be limited to refunding the Service Fee, less the non-refundable amount of AUD \$440.00 (inclusive of GST). The Mare Owner remains liable for all agistment and veterinary costs.

4. Abortion or Non-Viable Foal

If the Mare aborts or if the foal fails to stand and nurse, the Mare Owner may return the Mare for re-breeding in the following breeding season. No additional Service Fee shall be payable for such subsequent breeding.

All veterinary and agistment costs remain the responsibility of the Mare Owner. To qualify for such re-breeding, the Mare Owner must provide the Stallion Owner with (a) a certificate from a qualified veterinarian confirming the abortion or failure of the foal to stand and nurse, and (b) the Stallion Breeding Certificate, within ten (10) days of the event.

5. Breeding Certificates and Registration

Breeding certificates from the Australian Quarter Horse Association or Australian Stock Horse Society will only be issued where the Mare is registered with the relevant body at the time of execution of this Agreement. Copies of the Mare's registration certificates must be attached to this Agreement. No breeding certificate will be issued until full payment of the Service Fee has been received. Where a late stallion breeding return is required, the Mare Owner shall be liable for any applicable administration costs.

6. **Semen** will be collected at Maraboon Rural Vet Services, 221 Talafa Road Emerald Qld 4720;

- 6.1. For semen delivery to other breeding centres: The mare owner agrees to pay all collection costs, packaging & transport costs to Maraboon Rural Vet Services. (Not included in the service fee).
- 6.2. Semen is available only with sufficient prior notice (contact Maraboon Vet Services - Ph: (07) 4982 2552 for information) and if semen is required out of Maraboon Rural Vet Services business hours', additional fees may be charged by Maraboon Rural Vet Services.
- 6.3. Semen will only be collected upon Maraboon Rural Vet Services availability, and transport is possible during this period.
- 6.4. The semen consignment will be assessed by Maraboon Rural Vet Services to ensure that the quantity and motility are adequate to achieve pregnancy under normal breeding conditions.
- 6.5. Appropriate packaging and transport conditions are to be discussed with Maraboon Rural Vet Services (not stallion owner/s or W5C Group representatives). Appropriate transport methods will be organised through Maraboon Rural Vet Services, (not stallion owner/s or W5C Group representatives) and must arrive and be inseminated within a 24-hour window or as per the agreed Veterinary Clinics instructions.
- 6.6. The stallion owner/s or Maraboon Rural Vet Services are not liable for semen lost in transport or for delays in semen arriving to its destination and /or if this causes loss of motility to the live semen. The mare owner is responsible for any and all costs. Where additional semen is required, mare owners are to pay the additional collection fees and shipping expenses to Maraboon Rural Vet Services before additional semen is shipped.

7. **Service Fee Invoice**

A Service Fee invoice in the amount of AUD \$2,200.00 (inclusive of GST) shall be issued to the Mare Owner's nominated email address upon receipt by the Stallion Owner of the completed Breeding Contract, together with the Mare's registration certificate.

8. **This Agreement becomes binding** upon the Stallion Owners upon receipt of: (a) the Agreement duly executed by the Mare Owner; (b) a copy of the Mare's registration papers; and (c) payment of the service fee in accordance with the issued invoice. This Agreement is not transferable or assignable except with the prior written consent of both parties. An executed copy of this Agreement will be provided by email to the Stallion Owners, the Mare Owner, and Maraboon Rural Vet Services.
