1. Mare Details

2. Fees and Payment

- Stud Fee: \$2,000 plus GST
- Booking Fee: \$500 (non-refundable, payable at the time of booking)
- Payment Terms: Remaining balance payable after confirmation of pregnancy at 45 days via veterinary scan.- Additional Costs: All veterinary, farrier, transport, semen collection, and shipping costs are at the Mare Owner's expense.

The booking fee secures the mare's place for the breeding season and will be credited toward the total stud fee.

3. Breeding Method - Artificial Insemination Only

All breeding shall be carried out by Al using chilled semen collected from Roma One at Maraboon Rural Vet Services.

- Semen collection, preparation, and transport arranged by Maraboon Rural Vets.

- All collection and shipping fees are payable by Mare Owner. Semen remains the property of Stallion Owner and may not be used for any other mare or season without prior written approval.
- Every attempt to ship high quality semen will be made, however the Stallion Owner makes not guarantees or warranties and will not be held liable for any damaged or contaminated semen during or after shipping, loss of viability or any costs associated with shipment delays, damages or loss in transit.
- Please note if performing embryo transfer and multiple embryos are flushed and result in positive pregnancies, a separate service fee will be charged for each successful pregnancy.

4. Live Foal Guarantee

If the mare does not produce a live foal (a foal that stands and nurses unassisted for 24 hours), Mare Owner is entitled to a return service in the following breeding season, subject to:

- 1. Written notice to Stallion Owner within 7 days of foal's loss.
- 2. Veterinary certificate confirming the circumstances.
- 3. All accounts (other than stud fee) being fully paid.

No refunds provided. Live Foal Guarantee is not transferable unless agreed in writing.

5. Mare Care and Expenses

All veterinary, farrier, feed, and handling expenses are at Mare Owner's cost.

Stallion Owner and Maraboon Rural Vets will take reasonable care but accept no responsibility for illness, injury, escape, or death of mare or foal, however caused.

6. Liability

Each party agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other, their agents, and employees from any claim, loss, or damage arising from mare's breeding, care, transport, or handling, except in cases of proven negligence.

7. Registration and Breeding Certificates

Upon full payment and confirmation of a live foal, Stallion Owner will provide all necessary documentation to register the foal with the relevant breed association.

8. Jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws in Australia, and both parties submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of Australia.

9. Entire Agreement

This document constitutes the full and complete agreement between the parties. Any amendments must be made in writing and signed by both parties.
