We strongly advise any mare you intend to breed, are on a rising plane of nutrition for several weeks prior to ensure better results and less costs to mare owner.

All transport arrangements and costs shall be the responsibility of the mare owner. All veterinary costs associated with breeding to Vivid are the responsibility of the mare owner. While the mare and offspring are in the custody of the Stallion owner (or agent) they shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, injury or death which may be suffered by the above-mentioned mare or offspring, however all necessary precautions will be taken to insure their wellbeing.

The service fee is payable to the stallion owner Sherri Philp once a 45day pregnancy scan has been conducted. All fees in this contract include GST. All invoices are due on receipt.

Live Foal Guarantee: This is defined as the following: A negative pregnancy test after the mare has been declared pregnant by a qualified vet, or a still born foal. (LFG) is given with return service the following season. If the foal does not stand up and nurse, the Mare Owner will be entitled to a return service. This guarantee applies only if the Mare Owner notifies the Stallion Owner within one week from death of foal. This notice must be accompanied by a Statement from a licensed Veterinarian. If the Mare is to be returned and the Mare Owner fails to deliver her for re-breeding the following year, then all fees will be forfeited, and the return service will be lost. There is no LFG on the return service.

I/We agree that the attending veterinarian check my mare for normal breeding conditions and perform such other veterinary services as is deemed necessary at mare owner's expense. All mares must be halter broken and able to be hobbled. The stallion owner reserves the right to refuse any mare for service.

Please ensure all mares are in good condition, drenched and vaccinated for Tetanus/Strangles and have had feet trimmed just prior to arrival.
